This year we are going to be starting weekly times tables tests again on a Friday. We will be reintroducing the times tables around the world scheme. Every child will start again with the 2 and 10 times tables. The first test will be **Friday 13th September**. Please see the table below for the order of Countries and the tables to be learnt as your son/daughter moves around the World.



Countries	Times tables to learn	Rules
United Kingdom	2 and 10	<p>3 minutes strict – if you have one answer remaining you have not achieved promotion to the next league.</p> <p>Once you have completed a country, you receive a stamp in your passport and an adult will sign it with the date and your initials.</p> <p>After completing Brazil, Mr Carpenter/Mr Lawrence will give you a verbal 30 second test of 12 random multiplication and division based questions in order for you to gain entry back into the UK.</p>
France	2 and 5	
Spain	3 and 5	
Italy	3 and 4	
Egypt	3, 4 and 6	
Kenya	4, 6 and 8	
South Africa	6, 8 and 9	
India	7, 8 and 9	
Australia	7, 9, 12 and square numbers	
China	Division for 3, 4, 6 and 8	
Canada	Division for 6, 7, 8 and 9	
USA	Division for 7, 9, 12 and square roots	
Mexico	Random multiple facts	
Brazil	Random division facts	
United Kingdom	Any multiple or division (oral)
